



The Ontario County Department of Public Health issues Quarantine Order for Pre-K-12 staff exposed to COVID-19.

Employee is symptom free for 14 days from their last contact with the COVID 19 case.

AND

Employee is released from quarantine by the Ontario County Department of Public Health.

*** Employee can return to school.**

While in quarantine, employee has a temperature >100° OR has symptoms of COVID-19:

- Fever, chills
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Cough
- Nasal congestion/runny nose
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches

* Contact Ontario County Public Health (585-396-4803) to discuss if your employee is considered essential and can return to the workplace with restrictions during quarantine.

Employee does not get a COVID-19 test: The employee remains in quarantine for 14 days from onset of symptoms.

Employee gets COVID-19 with negative test result
The employee remains in quarantine.

COVID-19 test result is positive: The employee is placed in Isolation by the Public Health Director.

**Employee is released from Quarantine or Isolation by the Public Health Director.
